



Some of the proposals include a significant focus on service transformation. Many agencies are 'old fashioned' and performance improvement needs innovation in the what we manage and deploy services

Concerns about contribution to cost of short term staff appointment where issues might be argued to be an existing mainstream priority.

Funding may help to kick start certain activities and enable Wigan to address regional activity e.g. AWARM approach and targeted work to reduce seasonal deaths/fuel poverty etc

Cultural Olympiad is an initiative with wide benefits - but has no resources. It requires £100k to kick start programme of activities. It also:

- Brings opportunity to work with national programme and a wide range of benefits.
- Contributes significantly to our local aspirations agenda

Seeking to develop a preventative approach with families in public housing, scheme is part of a service transformation agenda. 'Challenge fund' will match if local funding is awarded

We clearly need to support further work to refresh domestic violence / abuse strategy – and to coordinate the work of all partners engaged. This needs to be factored into any work approved under this programme

### **2.3 Analysis and allocations**

3 key elements emerged in discussion:

- Delivery – focus on addressing performance issues
- Step change – enabling LSP and partners to transform approach
- Paradigm shift – innovation and improvement

### **2.4 Allocations**

In discussion 3 core strands of funding agreed:

£90k	Intervention with families developing a preventative approach
£250k	Health interventions
£160k	Domestic abuse interventions

It was agreed that these strands should be administered as mini programmes with partnership leads responsible for overseeing priority setting within the strands as needed.
